Livingston County Department of Health COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics *Hundreds of Slots Available on April 1, 2, 6*

Mount Morris, NY, March 31, 2021 — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) has hundreds of vaccination slots still available for its COVID-19 vaccine clinics on Thursday, April 1st, Friday, April 2nd, and Tuesday, April 6th. LCDOH is primarily using the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine and is scheduling vaccine clinics for New York residents who are:

- Essential workers in Phase 1a and 1b including:
 - Restaurant workers
 - Shared ride services such as taxi and Uber drivers
 - Public-facing government and public employees
 - Not-for-profit workers who provide public-facing services to New Yorkers in need
 - Essential in-person public-facing building service workers
- Individuals 30 years of age and older
- Those who are 18 years of age and older with chronic conditions like cancer, diabetes, heart conditions and lung disease.

Beginning April 6, universal eligibility goes into effect, and all New Yorkers 16 years of age and older will be eligible to receive the Pfizer vaccine. Pfizer is the only vaccine approved for 16 years and older. Please note that LCDOH is primarily using Moderna which is for 18 years of age and older.
