COVID-19 Update from Livingston County Department of Health

MOUNT MORRIS, N.Y., November 16, 2021 — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) reports that, as of November 15, 2021, there are 204 active COVID-19 cases in the county. This is triple the number of cases in Livingston County as compared to the same time last year.

Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director for Livingston County, stated, “As the colder weather and winter holidays begin to bring more people indoors, now is a good time to get your COVID-19 vaccination – including pediatric vaccines and booster doses for those who are eligible.”
