Livingston County Enhances Isolation and Quarantine Process with Self-Serve Component

MOUNT MORRIS, N.Y., Jan. 13, 2022 — As Livingston County continues to experience a surge of COVID-19 cases, Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) case investigators and contact tracers are no longer able to reach out to all cases in a timely manner. As such, LCDOH has implemented an online, self-serve system to enhance its isolation and quarantine process.

“Residents who have or who have been exposed to COVID-19 can now visit the County’s website to fill out and print their own isolation and quarantine orders or release notices required for work, school or other purposes,” said Livingston County Public Health Director Jennifer Rodriguez. “This self-serve option will increase the efficiency of the isolation and quarantine process while also placing more emphasis on personal responsibility. We want to thank our residents for working together to protect the health and safety of their communities, families and loved ones.”
