### **CMS Awards Four-Star Rating to Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation**

*New ranking places County facility among top nursing homes nationwide*

**GENESEO, N.Y., May 11, 2021** — The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) have awarded the Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation (LCCNR) with a Four-Star quality rating within their Five-Star Quality Rating System.

The new rating improves upon the LCCNR's previous Three-Star designation and places the facility "above average" when compared to other nursing homes throughout the state and country. CMS considers a number of factors when creating rankings, including health inspection, quality measures, staffing, and registered nurse staffing. The LCCNR's Four-Star rating is a well-deserved accomplishment and a direct result of the care and dedication of the County-run facility's staff, said LCCNR Deputy Director of Long Term Care Eric Townsend.

"The staff and I are so proud of this achievement. To be recognized for all the hard work put into creating a caring and nurturing environment for our residents is really something special," he said. "It's very difficult to receive a rating like this. My hat is off to all our incredible employees who work so hard to make the LCCNR a better place for our residents to live each and every day."

CMS created the Five-Star Quality Rating System to help consumers, their families, and caregivers more easily compare nursing homes throughout the U.S. The Nursing Home [Care Compare](#) web site features nursing home ratings with breakdowns for each of the four scoring criteria.

The LCCNR offers 24-hour skilled nursing services ranging from short-term, post-acute rehabilitative care to traditional long-term care. Residents receive care in a manner that addresses the needs of the individual. The LCCNR promotes a friendly, welcoming atmosphere with activities that involve friends, family, volunteers, and pets in creating a homelike environment for residents.
