Course Description: The Officer Development – Firefighter Health & Safety course provides current and potential fire officers with a basic knowledge of how to determine company-level training needs, how to teach from a lesson plan, how to document training activities, and different methods of conducting company-level training. Additionally, it covers the basic responsibilities of the fire officer as they relate to community relations, company-level building inspections, and community risk reduction.

Based on the requirements found in Chapter 4 of NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications. Successful completion of this course, along with the Company Training & Community Risk Reduction, Leadership & Supervision, Planning and Emergency Response, and Fire ground Strategy and Tactics for First Arriving Companies modules allows the student to apply for a Fire Officer I certificate.
