Summer Safety Tips

Keep your pets safe

Fireworks & Thunderstorms: Secure your dogs indoors in an escape proofed area and turn on the radio or tv.

Sun & Heat: Know the signs of overheating (excessive panting, increased heartrate and weakness). Keep your dogs indoors or in a cool, shady place.

Chemicals: Keep insecticides, citronella products, glow sticks and many other things that are toxic away from pets.

Parties & BBQ's: Try to resist feeding your dogs human food. Keep alcoholic beverages and garbage out of reach.

Hot Cars: Even with your windows down the temperature inside a vehicle can become deadly in a short period of time.

Items used at Dog Control

We are often asked what people can donate to our shelter. We could typically use:

- Canned & dry dog food
- Dog treats
- Martingale type collars & leashes
- Dog toys & stuffed animals
- Used towels, sheets & small blankets
- Laundry detergent & Dawn dish soap
- Spray cleaners, bleach & paper towels

We can also accept any other dog related items (crates, beds etc.) , grooming supplies, and flea/tick preventative items.
