Course Description: Provides information and techniques to perform more complex vertical rope rescues. Builds on the Rope Rescue Operations course with more advanced individual and team-based skills and high-angle rescue techniques. Designed to improve rescuer decision making when confronted with complex rescue situations. Topics covered include: ascending, anchoring, rescue and team-based pickoffs, knot passing, twin-tensioned rope systems, advanced litter rigging, horizontal movement, and the use of Artificial High Directionals. Course includes continuous skills evaluations and a final written exam.

Together with the NYS Rope Rescue Operations course, this course covers all the job performance requirements listed in the NFPA 1006 Rope Rescue Technician (2021 ed.)

Designed for emergency response personnel with responsibility in rope rescue. **32 hours**
